There are three aliens and they land on planet earth. The dad goes into a football stadium. The mum goes into a knife and fork shop. The baby goes into a mee mee shop.

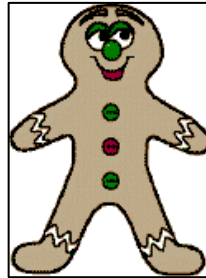
