Dear Parents,

On Oct 6th a Theatre group will be visiting for a production of the “Wizard of Oz”. We ask for a voluntary donation of £1 towards costs. If your child is in reception and you feel that they would benefit from seeing real theatre please let Mrs Cinicola know and they can stay with us for the whole day.

The Harvest Service will be at Church on the 13th October at 9.45am. We will walk all children down except the reception age group who do not attend this first service. You are welcome to attend the service, which is organised by class 4. We ask for donations of produce, including tins etc, which we take down with us and then we sell them back to you at some extortionate profit after school! The money will then be given to the Bishop of Taunton at a special service for all the Church Schools on the 15th, and the proceeds will go towards work in Zimbabwe. Our children have designed tiles to go towards four large plaques which will be exhibited in a public place in town after the service to celebrate the 1100th anniversary of the Diocese of Bath and Wells.

On Nov 8th a few children from school along with Josh Mycock from Heathfield will represent us at the parish’s Remembrance day Service at Church at 3.00pm. Poppies will be on “sale” at school before this and we will hold a minute’s silence at 11.00am on the 11th November.

Two more INSET dates have been decided: The 22nd and 23rd July have been taken so there is just one more to organise. We will let you know when we have decided.

Finally just a reminder please.. it may seem mean but the car park is only for staff and visitors, as the sign indicates. Please do not park in there as it can cause problems. Also please do not walk across the car park. It is dangerous and we have built additional footpaths to make this unnecessary.
