17th December- Christmas dinner/Christmas jumper day

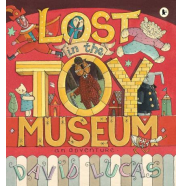

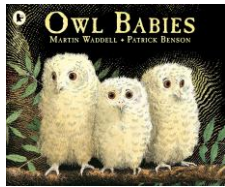
CLL

This half term we will be continuing our focus on **place value** building on our understanding of numbers from 0-10 and extending this to numbers from 11-20.

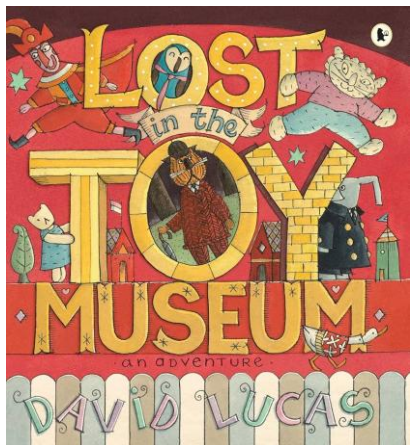
PSHE
