




Communication, Language & Literacy

Science and Technology

Living Things and Their Habitats (including Evolution)

- describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics.
- Learn about significance of the work of scientists such as Carl Linnaeus, a pioneer of classification.
- give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics in the context of sorting and grouping animals for a zoo.
- identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.
- explain how living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago

We will explain some of the different ways individuals show their beliefs and recognise and express feelings about their own identities


We will explain why different religious communities may have a different view of what is right and wrong and show awareness of morals and right and wrong.
